

4th, 5th, and 6th Grade Rules

Class Rules

1. Respect others' right to learn.
2. Treat others the way you would want to be treated.
3. Follow all class procedures.
4. Follow directions the 1st TIME. No talking while I am teaching.
5. Raise your hand and wait for permission to speak.
6. No gum, candy, food, or flavored drinks in class.

Consequences

1st offense: 2 points deducted from conduct grade.

2nd offense: Pole duty. 2 points deducted from conduct grade.

3rd offense: Student-Teacher conference and parent(s) will be notified. 2 days of pole duty. 2 points deducted from conduct grade.

4th offense: Office Referral to the Principal and parent conference for behavior offenses. 2 points deducted from conduct grade.

Severe misbehaving may result in an immediate office referral. The school principal will assign the appropriate form of punishment such as Before School Detention, ISS, corporal punishment, or any other punishment necessary.

ABS (Assignments, Behavior, Supplies)

Every Monday, each homeroom group will take a conduct folder from class to class. When a rule is broken, one of the above codes will be marked resulting in the above consequences. Each student will be given 100 points each 6 weeks for a conduct grade. Points will be deducted for each offense. The amount of points you lose subtracted from 100 will be your conduct grade for the 6 weeks.

Rewards

- Those who have not signed the clipboard all day will receive 1 ticket in order to earn a chance for the prize drawing each Friday. 4 names will be drawn. The more tickets you have in the box, the better chance you have to win.
- Students with a 100 conduct grade at the end of the 6 weeks may receive one of the following: recess, food, lunch with the teacher, free time.
