Activities: Choose an animal from the list below.

1. Do research and write a one page report.
2. Create a power point.
3. Draw, color and label a picture of a marine animal from the list below on construction paper or poster board.
4. Create a poem or song about one of the Sea World animals.
5. Research the, Marine Mammal Protection Act, and explain what it is and why it became an Act. Be able to explain how the Act affects exotic and native animals. Be sure to name at least 2 types of animals affected.
6. Use the library or internet to research the Humboldt Penguin. Describe and explain how humans have threatened their extinction and what would happen if they did become extinct. How would that change their environment
7. Some people say, "The only good shark is a dead shark!" What do you think? Explain why. Make a list of good things sharks do and why they are important in their habitat/niche.
